**Hubbard County Senior Meals** are funded through Lutheran Social Services Senior Nutrition. The program serves nutritionally balanced meals to senior citizens 60 years and older (and their spouse, regardless of age). Their mission is to help older adults live independently in their home for as long as possible, preventing premature institutionalization as a result of malnutrition and other health related issues.

Three dining options are available:

- **Community Dining** Well-balanced and affordable meals in a friendly community atmosphere
- Meals on Wheels Volunteers deliver the fresh hot meals and a smile to home-bound seniors.

Local restaurants offer senior dining meals throughout the day.

Cash donations are always appreciated by the Senior Nutrition Council.
